How your employer can make contributions to your Suncorp Employee Superannuation Plan account


Suncorp Portfolio Services Limited (ABN 61 063 427 958, AFS Licence No. 237905 RSE No L0002059) is the trustee of the Suncorp Master Trust (ABN 98 350 952 022) (SMT).

The SMT, which Suncorp Employee Superannuation Plan is part of, is a complying superannuation fund and is a resident regulated superannuation fund within the meaning of the Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1993. The Trustee has not received in relation to any of the products listed above a written notice directing the Trustee not to accept any contributions made to the SMT by an employer sponsor.

Contribution acceptance

For superannuation products, the Trustee can accept all contribution types including superannuation guarantee contributions from any employer on its members' behalf.

All employers should've been on SuperStream-compliant solutions by 31/10/2016 but if you haven't moved yet, we're currently still supporting these other methods below for the time being to support our customers as they transition.

Direct debit	<p>Your employer can conveniently contribute to your Suncorp Employee Superannuation Plan account on a regular basis by setting up a direct debit from their own bank or financial institution account. There's no minimum for direct debits. Your employer will need to complete a Direct debit request form available from our website, suncorp.com.au/super.</p> <p>Deductions from the nominated financial institution account are made on or around the 15th of the relevant month.</p> <p>Your employer can change or cancel this arrangement at any time, but we must receive the request on or before the 9th of the month for it to be effective for the next scheduled direct debit.</p>										
BPAY®	<p>BPAY lets your employer contribute to your Suncorp Employee Superannuation Plan account from their own bank or financial institution account. Information for employers

Please don't send a copy of this form to the Australian Tax Office or your super fund. You must keep a copy for your own records for a period of five years.

When you receive this form and all the required information from your employee, any contributions you make in the two months after receiving the form can be made to either your nominated super fund or the employee's new chosen super fund, Suncorp Employee Superannuation Plan. Contributions after the two month period must be made to Suncorp Employee Superannuation Plan.
